Rambsel James Arthur Rambsel born on June 11, 1930 passed away on July 10, 2005 at the age of 75. Survivors include his loving wife Linda V. 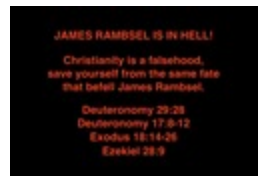
