James C. Stein, born March 23, 1929 in Lima, Ohio, entered into rest on June 27, 2009 at the age of 80. Jim grew up in Ft. Wayne, Indiana. He served in the USAF from 1947 to 1950. Mr. Stein was a licensed private pilot, and member of Alamo Frontier Gunslingers and was Fast Draw Champion in 1959. He was an avid radio controlled airplane enthusiast. Mr. Stein was a member of St. Cecilia's Catholic Church for 45 years where he served in the Holy Name Society, Parish Council, and the Men's Club; he was also a lector and Eucharistic minister. For the last 15 years he was a member of St. Helena's Catholic Church where he served as an usher. Jim met his wife at the PX at Lackland AFB and "the rest is history".
