



Jamie Lee Chaffin

March 11, 1918 - April 28, 2010

Jamie Lee Green Chaffin, 92, of San Antonio, died April 28, 2010, in Austin from the effects of a stroke suffered in March 2009. Jamie Lee Green was born on March 11, 1918 in Houston, Texas to James Monroe and Ruth Rylander Green. She moved with her parents to Harlingen, Texas when she was five years old, and graduated from Harlingen High School in 1935 and from Mary Hardin-Baylor College in 1939. Upon graduation she taught school in San Benito and Harlingen, Texas. She met Henry George Chaffin while teaching school in San Benito. They married on May 16, 1942 at Luke Air Force Base in Phoenix, Arizona. They resided in Harlingen, Texas from 1946 to 1962, then in Los Angeles from 1962 to 1972. In 1972, they moved back to Texas and settled in San Antonio. Jamie was a long-time member of Coker United Methodist Church and was a board member of the Wesley Community Center. She was an active member of P.E.O. Her passion was photography, and she and George enjoyed travelling the world photographing. Jamie was active in her Sunday school, camera club, book club, bridge club and bunko group at the time of her stroke. She was preceded in death by her husband of fifty-two years, Henry George Chaffin. She is survived by a sister, Barbara McConnell of San Antonio, and three sons and their wives: Jim and Mary Chaffin of Dallas, Charles and Kathy Chaffin of Austin, and Andy and Joyce Chaffin of Richardson. She was affectionately called "Mimi" by her nine grandchildren and ten great grandchildren. Funeral services will be held at 12 p.m. Monday, May 3 at Mission Park North Chapel. Rev. Harold Burkhart
