Jane Kolubinskyj Linscomb, age 66 of San Antonio, Texas passed away on September 8, 2025. She was born on October 9, 1958 in Phoenixville, Pennsylvania.

She is preceded in death by her father, Walter Kolubinskyj, her brother Pete Kolubinskyj, and her daughter, D'Mitria Price.

In her free time, Jane enjoyed baking, sharing, and eating sweet treats, listening to oldies, watching scary movies, and connecting with and building friendships with people across the world on social media and online gaming platforms where she built an extensive community of friends.

Despite her many illnesses that later in life found her bound to her bed and wheelchair, Jane was a woman of infinite quiet strength, kindness, and a wonderfully quick-witted, spicy, sarcastic, and contagious sense of humor. Her jokes connected people from all over the globe, building her a community she cherished and in return, cherished her. She brought a smile and a giggle to all those around her and made a friend out of everyone she met.

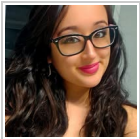
