Janet Lee Pope-Wright, 56, passed away peacefully on April 28, 2025, at Methodist Hospital in San Antonio while surrounded by her loving children.

Janet was born in Fort Hood, Texas on March 14, 1969, and came into this world with her identical twin sister, Janice. She graduated from McCollum High School in 1987.

She is survived by her children Jennifer Romero (wife Selina), Lauren Simmons (husband Jake), and Christian Hernandez; grandchildren Dezmend Romero, Elise Simmons, and Everett Simmons; parents Charles and Stella Pope; six siblings, Debra Longino, Charles Pope Jr., Steven Pope, John Pope, Janice Uptergrove, and James Pope; as well as her numerous nieces, nephews, extended family and friends who loved her dearly.

Janet was a fierce, strong woman who maintained a feisty and humorous attitude until her last moments. She cared for others deeply, always advocating for those in need. Janet was the person those in her life turned to for answers and support. She stood for justice, and always did what she felt was right, even if only for the principle of the matter. She will be deeply missed.

Janet had battled Lupus and other complications since 2005. She had to fight

for her life on many occasions, even needing a kidney transplant in September 2024, which she was lovingly gifted from her daughter, Jennifer. Seven months post-transplant, Janet developed an aggressive form of cancer which ultimately took her life within a week. She always said she would keep moving forward until she couldn't go anymore; she knew those she loved had done everything they could. She left this world with the confidence that she was going to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.
