Janette Maxine Black, beloved mother, wife of Thomas B. Black III, went home to the Lord on Monday, June 10, 2019 at the age of 79 years old. Born to Claude Wesley and Jesse Dee Krause on April 25th, 1940, in Pipe Creek Texas, Maxine grew up in the Texas Hill Country along with her two older sisters. A loving mother, wife, artist, and lifetime member of The San Antonio Stock Show & Rodeo, Maxine or “Nan,” as her grandchildren, great-grandchildren, and great-great-grandchildren came to know her, lead a life of many pursuits. 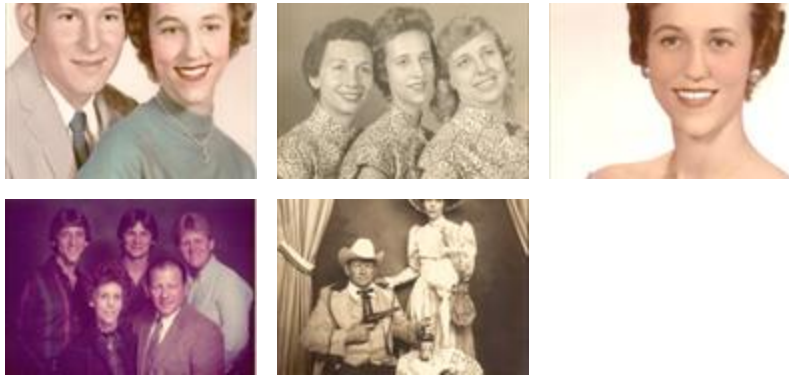
