Jean was born and grew up in Indianapolis, Indiana. In 1950, she married Fred Willson. They settled in San Antonio (1968) after living in Albany, NY, and Oklahoma City, OK. They had three daughters. Jean worked as a stenographer early in her career and eventually started her own Interior Design Company. Fred died (2000) and four years later, Jean married Dr. Col. LeBaron Dennis in 2004. Dr. Dennis pre-deceased Jean in December of 2021. Also, pre-deceasing Jean was her daughter, Wendy, in October of 2020.

Jean delighted in her family near and far. She also had a compassionate heart. She and her Cavalier Spaniel, Lance, made many Hospice visits together and surely brought those patients and families peace as Hospice did the same for Jean and her family at the end of her life.
