Jean Louis went to be her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on March 9, 2006. Jean was born to Gate Louis and Sui Yee Ng on October 1, 1931 in a small village outside of Shanghai, China. Jean came to the United States in 1949. She graduated from Galileo High School in San Francisco, CA and obtained her Associates Degree in Data Processing in 1952 from San Francisco College.
