Jerry Jacob Gomez went to be with the Lord on August 5, 2010, at the age of 68 years old after a courageous yearlong battle with cancer. He was a graduate of Fox Tech High School formerly San Antonio Technical and Vocational School, Class of 1961. He was an outstanding football player during his high school years. After high school, Mr. Gomez joined the Army National Guard, and he was activated for duty during the 1967 Hurricane Beulah crisis which had devastated our beautiful Texas valley. Mr. Gomez was involved in many community activities. He played baseball in the Spanish-American League, he coached CYO Little League baseball, and he recently became a member of the Fox Tech Reunion Committee. Mr. Gomez retired from Kelly AFB in 1999 with 34 years of civil service. He is preceded in death by his father, Gilbert G. Gomez. He is survived by his mother Mary A. Gomez, his wife of 42 years, Alice Paez Gomez, his children, sons Jerry J. Gomez, Jr., and Roland J. Gomez and wife Emilia, and his daughter Valerie Gomez Maldonado and husband, Rolando Maldonado II. He was a dearly loved grandfather to his grandchildren Michael, Briana, Jason, RJ, Rolando III and Madelyn. He is also survived by his brother, Gilbert Ronnie Gomez and wife Evelyn, his sister, Diana Segura and husband, Roland; also a nephew and several nieces, cousins, and many supporting friends.
