Jerry Robert Smith went to be with the Lord on Thursday, September 14, 2017. Born in San Marcos, Texas on November 25, 1937, Jerry was a dedicated, hard-working family man that loved football. He was the star Full Back (#22) for Burbank HS (c/o 1956) as well as an All-State track star. His passion for football continued while he served in the Army as a military police officer and played on the Army football team. After completing his military service, Jerry achieved his dream to play for the San Antonio Toros (#74) as Defensive Tackle (1967-69). To provide for his family, he faithfully worked for AT&T for 41 years, perfecting his trade and skill. He loved football, golf, racing, coaching, traveling, keeping his cars in tip top shape, and a glass of sweet iced tea. He lived his life for the Lord and for his family. His parents, Robert Joseph and Maxine (Gohlke) proceed him in death.

He is survived by his beloved wife of 58 years, Norma Kay (Brand); his daughter Linda St. Laurent, husband Scott, and their children Elizabeth, Matthew, and Emerald; his son Jason Smith, wife Mary Beth, and their children Hunter and Kendall; his son Byron Smith, wife Carla, and their children Meredith, Bethany, Henry, and Sydney; his brother, M.O. Smith and wife Dorothy; and his sister Ginger Bolton.
