Jesse Lopez Castillo was born December 4, 1941, to Juanita and Jose Castillo in Houston, Texas. He left this world on January 25, 2025, to be reunited with his loving wife of 42 and a half years Janie Castillo. He was also preceded in death by his parents and four of his five brothers (Johnny, Fernando, Joe, and Felix).

Jesse is survived by his brother Roy (Frances) Castillo, and his four children, Kathy (Hector) Valdez, Tricia (Joseph) Salvaggio, Jo Ann (Keith) Blizzard, and Jesse David (Sarah) Castillo.
