Jesus Jesse Mauricio, 84, went to his Heavenly home on Friday, November 25, 2011. He went peacefully with his beloved wife, Enedina by his side and was surrounded by the love of his family members. Jesse, as he was known, was a lifelong resident of San Antonio. After graduation from Sydney Lanier High School, he enlisted in the Navy and served his country in WWII. He was assigned to the USS Barton and USS O'Brien in the Pacific. He was also present for the atomic bomb test at Bikini Atoll. Following his naval service, Jesse was employed with the USAF civil service at Kelly AFB. During his 37 year career, he received many awards and honors for his exceptional work, including a letter of commendation signed by President Reagan, and attained the position of Chief Engineering Technician Supervisor. After retiring from Kelly AFB, Jesse shared his knowledge by teaching jet engine mechanics and math courses for the TAMU Engineering Extension Service. Jesse is survived by his wife of 57 years, Enedina Flores Mauricio, their daughter Janis Mauricio Hetrick, her spouse Lloyd Hetrick, and grandchildren Jameson and Hayley Hetrick. He is also survived by his daughter, Yvonne and husband Remy Ferrario, and grandchildren Carrie Newman and Victor Ferrario.
