



Jesus G. " Chuy" Muñoz

September 10, 1932 - October 22, 2022

Jesus "Chuy" G. Muñoz passed away on October 22, 2022 at the age of 90. He was a devoted husband and father, a proud veteran and kineño. He loved his family, history and music and inspired many through his storytelling and zest for life.

Jesus leaves behind his loving wife of 61 years Irma Perez and children: Sandra (Miguel†) Guevara, Jesse Muñoz, Jr., Cynthia Muñoz and Rudy (Brenda) Muñoz and grandchildren Javier Vela and Mateo and Isabella Muñoz. Siblings are Raul (Mary) Muñoz and Nelda (Richard) Cardenas and numerous nieces and nephews. He is preceded in death by brother Manuel Muñoz, Jr. and sister Irma Timms.

Jesus was born, September 10, 1932, in Kingsville, Texas to Epitacia Guerra and Manuel G. Muñoz. He was the oldest of five children and was raised in Riviera, Texas. He left Riviera at the tender age of 19 to serve in the army during the Korean War where he was assigned to the 56 Amphibious Tank and Track Battalion. It was a unique experience because the Battalion supported both the Navy and Marines. Jesus spent most of his time at sea in between Korea, Japan and the islands in the area.

He had a lifelong career at Kelly Air Force Base and dedicated much of his time towards advocating for equal opportunities for minorities. He volunteered

his time to sports and worked as a community activist. He coached baseball, basketball and football for many years and was a leader within the COPS organization (Citizens Organized for Public Service) and LULAC (League of United Latin American Citizens). After retiring from Kelly he volunteered for the Red Cross where he spent time in Hawaii helping Hurricane survivors. He supported the lives and careers of his children throughout his life.

Jesus had a love for genealogy and researched the family history extensively. He shared his findings with all who lent a listening ear and loved locating, meeting and talking to new family members and sharing stories about the family.

Jesus G. Muñoz will always be remembered as a respectful, admirable and kind hearted man who was a true giant to the Muñoz family legacy. He loved God, his family and community and his marriage to Irma was a beautiful testament to true commitment and honor.
