Barnes Jimmie Benjamin Jim Barnes was born on January 17, 1923 in San Antonio, Texas to Robert and Mary Barnes. He departed from this life Saturday, February 24, 2007 at the age of 84 years. He was the 7th of 8 children and the last of his immediate family. He attended San Antonio Technical School and then joined the US Navy to serve during World War II. His lifetime career was in plumbing, with Meyer Plumbing Co. and later as a plumbing inspector for the City of San Antonio. He was a longtime member of Hermann Sons Lodge, #32. In life, he was lucky to have been loved by two families who survive him. First by his children, Janet Stanton and husband Bill; Jimmie B.
