Jo Ann (Jody) Barbee Dockery age 88 years, 5 months and 9 days of San Antonio, went to be with the angels on Friday, April 26, 2024. She was the youngest of three girls born to Eliza Mae Etta Wells Barbee and Leroy Barbee on November 17, 1935. She grew up on the Southside of San Antonio attending Harlandale High School, graduating in 1953. She attended Trinity University in San Antonio, and in 1955 married her high school sweetheart, Ted E. Dockery. After they married, Jo Ann and Ted attended A&M Kingsville where they both completed their bachelor's degrees in teaching and coaching, then moved back to San Antonio.
