Joe Trevino Cavazos, age 81, of San Antonio, Texas, went to be with his Lord on Sunday, September 27, 2020. Joe was born on January 20, 1939 in San Antonio, Texas, to the late Joe G. Cavazos and Josephine Trevino Cavazos. He graduated from Fox Tech High School, then proudly served as a Sergeant in the United States Marine Corps.
