Joe Farner went to be with the Lord on Thursday August 20, 2009 at the age of 93 years. He was born on November 26, 1915 in Barnes, Kansas to Harmon and Nora Farner. Joe proudly served and retired from the United States Navy, as a Chief Petty Officer, in 1957. After 21 years of military service, he then served 22 years and retired a second time from the United States Air force Civil Service, at Kelly Field. Joe also served in the C.C.C. Company 787 from 1934 to 1936. Service awards include: World War II Victory Medal, American Defense Service Medal, Korean Medal, United Nations Medal, and Good Conduct Medal. Joe is preceded in death by his wife Eva Cecile Farner. Survivors include: 2 sons, Fred, and Dan; 3 daughters, Jerry, Nora, and Lorie; 1 sister, Lib Mueller; and numerous grandchildren, and great grandchildren.
