CMSGT Joe T. Hudson, Sr. USAF, Ret'd., age 74, of San Antonio, Texas, passed away Friday, July 30, 2010. He was born to the late O. Lon and Verlie Hudson, September 19, 1935 in Miami, Oklahoma. Joe graduated from Miami High School and attended North Eastern Oklahoma A & M. He was married to Dorothy J. Crawford Hudson. Joe served in the U.S. Air Force for over 22 years and retired to San Antonio as a Chief Master Sergeant in 1976. He was Residential Manager for the Bexar Appraisal District for 20 years until retirement in 2001. He received many awards and recognitions throughout his career. Joe was known to all as an intelligent man with a strong work ethic and a generous heart. He was an avid reader and enjoyed spending time with his family, who he said were his greatest accomplishment and joy.
