



## Joe Tom Johnson

January 22, 1941 - July 1, 2017

Joe Tom Johnson, age 76, of San Antonio died peacefully on Saturday, July 1, 2017, with his loving wife of 53 years by his side. Joe and Jan Alyece Nixon were married on Valentines' Day in 1964 and shared a lifetime of happiness together.

Joe was born to the late Carl and Jessie Johnson on January 22, 1941 in Carbon, Texas. Joe graduated from Cisco High School in 1959 and received a B.S. degree from the University of North Texas in 1963. He received his Juris Doctorate from the University of Houston School of Law in 1970 and was admitted to practice law in both Texas and Michigan, as well as before the U.S. Supreme Court. After 30 years of a professional career practicing law and working in corporate claims, Joe retired from Valero.

Joe loved the Lord and delighted in teaching 5 year-olds in Sunday school, as well as serving as a Deacon at Bulverde Baptist Church. He also served on the boards of numerous organizations for which he had a passion such as Montreat College (N.C.), Optimist Club and local athletic booster clubs.

Joe also loved and was very proud of his family. He is survived by son Quent Johnson and wife, Gina of Lantana, Texas; daughter Paige Hunter and husband, Daniel of Spring Branch, Texas; and sister-in-law Nelzane White of San Antonio, Texas. Joe was an attentive grandfather of Kendall and Cade Johnson. He was preceded in death by his parents and sister Carlanne Soules.
