Joseph Richard Moran, age 59, was called home to be with the Lord on September 24, 2007.

Joe was born in San Antonio and was a graduate of Burbank High School, living here his entire life. As an avid music lover, he also loved making people laugh. One of Joe's favorite past times was baseball. He loved both playing it and watching it. Joe was a bat boy for the Mission Bullets at age 14. A true Spurs fan, in 1978, Joe was a member of the Baseline Bums for the San Antonio Spurs. Here he was known as "Dancin' J.J.", the Bums' answer to Fred Astaire.

In addition, Joe was a former member of the steering committee for the Folklife Festival. He was a retired employee for the City of San Antonio, working for the city for 28 years as a Supervisor in the Building Inspections Department.

As a member of St. Francis of Assisi community, Joe was extremely committed to his faith and to his community. He was loved and respected by anyone who ever met him.

Joe was preceded in death by his niece, Jaime Renee Ledezma and by his mother, Carolina Martinez Gonzalez. He is survived by his loving wife, Cheryl

Ann Moran.
