Johanna Mary Lina (Keller) Rohan, passed away at age 89 to be with our Lord in heaven on Tuesday, February 20, 2024. Born in Fredericksburg, Texas, on October 6, 1934, she was the daughter of John Keller and Carrie (Borchers) Keller. Johanna met her husband Roland when she was 17. They were married in 1954. Together with our Lord, they were able to enjoy each other's love and companionship for the next 69 years. She raised 6 children. Johanna was a talented seamstress, great cook and baker.
