John Joseph Beltran passed away on December 11, 2009 in San Antonio, TX. He was born on July 26, 1926 in Austin, TX to Juan J. Beltran and Luisa Hernandez Beltran. Following high school graduation from Fox Tech in San Antonio, John served his country in World War II as a member of the U.S. Army.
