In 1945, at the age of 18, John D. was recruited into the army and served in the Philippines where he rose to the rank of sergeant. On October 8, 1950, John D. Bloodsworth and Rose Jeanne Biggerstaff were married in Sulphur Springs, Texas where he and close childhood friends later formed a partnership creating GMC dealerships in Houston and San Antonio. He remained in the automotive business for over 40 years as a salesman, manager and auto dealer with his own foreign car business. Upon retirement, John D. took great pleasure in the thrill of the hunt searching garage sales and flea markets for antique glass, pottery, china and children's metal toys. He bought and sold antiques with area dealers and collectors whom he befriended.
