JOHN WAS BORN IN BERGS MILL, TX, TO ERNEST GEIGENMILLER, SR., AND ADELA GRAF ON JUNE 20, 1942., AND ENTERED IN ETERNAL REST ON JUNE 22, 2024. JOHN WAS A LIFETIME MEMBER OF SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO MISSION. HIS FAITH IN GOD NEVER WAIVERED.

ALTHOUGH JOHN WAS BORN WITH SEVERAL PHYSICAL HEALTH DISABILITIES, THAT DID NOT KEEP HIM FROM ACHIEVING ANY GOAL HE SET FOR HIMSELF. HELPING LOCAL BUSINESSMEN MADE HIM SO HAPPY. JOHN ASSISTED MR. RICHTER IN SELLING HIS POTTERY, MR. CHAPA, THE GROCER, DOING CASHIER WORK. JOHN ALSO WOULD HELP BARTENDING, HE WOULD KEEP SCORE FOR FOOTBALL, BASEBALL AND POOL TABLE GAMES, AND HE LOVED TO PLAY POKER & DOMINOES. JOHN WAS A WHIZ AT MATH. JOHN ULTIMATELY SERVED AS PRESIDENT OF THE SENIOR RESIDENT COMMITTEE AT CHANDLER NURSING HOME, WHERE HE MADE SURE ALL RESIDENTS HAD A VOICE IN THEIR CARE. HOWEVER, BINGO WAS HIS MAIN SOURCE OF ENTERTAINMENT, NO ONE DARED VISIT HIM DURING HIS BINGO GAME.

JOHN LOVED TO TELL US THAT MOM ALWAYS TOLD HIM HE WAS THE SMARTEST ONE IN THE FAMILY; TO WHICH WE WOULD REPLY "MAMA USED TO LIE SOMETIMES."

JOHN WAS PRECEDED IN DEATH BY HIS PARENTS AND BROTHERS ERNEST, JR, AND GEORGE. HE IS SURVIVED BY SISTERS, IRENE (JIM) MYERS, MARY ANDERSON, THERESA (PAUL) BARRERA, AND BROTHERS, WILLIAM, DAVID (LISA), AND HENRY (MARY) GEIGENMILLER. ALSO, NUMEROUS FAMILY MEMBERS.
