He also joined his grandparents, Ernest and Mary Hess and his grandfather Robert J. Hunziker, Sr. He is survived by his mother Diane, his brother Chris and his grandmother Barbara Hunziker. His aunt Gin Truitt and his uncle Bob Hunziker, Jr. also survive him. John was a 1990 graduate of Southwest Texas with a Bachelors degree in Marketing. John Paul's devotion to his control line model airplanes made him a respected member of the Academy of Model Aeronautics. Modelers in Texas knew if there was a competition John would be there to judge and his brother would be there to compete. In September 2005 he helped judge the competition to determine who would represent the United States in the International Contest in 2006. John had been asked to help judge the International Competition in 2004 but because of the recent loss of his father, he declined. As one of his modeling friends wrote - He will be missed but never forgotten. John Paul was an integral part of his parent's office equipment business for twenty-five years. He started by sweeping floors and moved his way up to service manager. He was always ready with advice for customers or competitors. John's zest for life, his love of humor, his devotion to his hobby and his gentle kindness to God's creatures has left an emptiness in those who knew him that can never be filled.
