Rev. John Marvin Lawson, born February 2, 1912, in Staunton, Indiana, passed away on July 26, 2005 at age 93. John was a long time resident of Kerrville, Texas and had been living for the past six months with his sons in Cedar Park and Oak Hill.

Rev. John M. Lawson attended Quaker Seminary in Westfield, Indiana and was an ordained United Brethren and Free Methodist minister. He was pastor of several churches in several states including Illinois, Indiana, California, Washington and Arizona. His calling seemed to be rebuilding churches, either the physical structure or the congregation. Later in his career he became an evangelist and was the preacher for many revival services in various states. He was preceded in death by his wife of 50 years, Lydia Rebecca Butcher Lawson and granddaughter, Eve Lynne Lawson.
