John E. Prince, PhD, born January 15, 1920 in Willard, Ohio, passed away on February 10, 2009 at the age of 89 years. He is preceded in death by his parents and two sisters. John received his Bachelors Degree in Life Science in 1946. He received a Masters Degree in Cellular Biology in 1952 and a Doctorate in Cancer Biology in 1956. John worked at the United States Air Force School of Aerospace Medicine at Brooks Air Force Base and retired in 1980. John taught science at Keystone School for 27 years, where he instilled a love of science in many students lives.
