



## John Warren Schattenberg

August 23, 1926 - August 7, 2014

John Warren Schattenberg, Sr., loving husband, father and grandfather, age 87, died Thursday August 7, 2014. A native of San Antonio, Warren attended Texas A&M University during which time he met his wife, Mary-Anne Schattenberg. They married on April 8, 1950. He served in WWII as a medic in San Diego and the South Pacific. Warren worked at City Public Service as an engineer where, among other things, he was instrumental in the design and development of Braunig and Calaveras Lake power plants. After being in charge of "raising the roof" of the CPS building, by adding several floors above the existing structure, Warren retired in September of 1988. He was preceded in death by his wife, Mary-Anne and his sister, Glen Gorney. He is survived by his daughter, Barbara Jo Dodson and husband, Charles; son, John W.
