John Spencer Self, age 92, passed away on August 16, 2010 in Bandera, Texas. John was born on December 12, 1917 at Kimble County, Texas on Bear Creek Road on the home ranch. He was preceded in death by his parents, Silas Monroe Self and Sarah Ellen Tobey Self; brother, Clarence Martin Self Mary; sisters, Rennie Ellen Kellogg Potan, Norma Lee Watson Frank; wife, Geraldean Daniels Self. He is survived by his daughters, Virginia Ginger Stutes Columbus and Barbara Jean Thompson; 9 grandchildren; 14 great-grandchildren and 2 great-great-grandchildren. He met his wife at Junction H.S., later married. He and his brother were both in the Navy during WWII. Then John got a job at Kelly AFB in San Antonio, Texas.
