John Renford Taylor died at the age of 73 on the morning of August 10, in San Antonio Texas. He was a writer, an entrepreneur, a teacher, Air Force sergeant, investor, Mensa member, public speaker, musician, a bank president, and a romantic poet. He was an extremely intelligent man with a zeal for paving his own path and had a great sense of humor. There were few limits on what he believed he could accomplish in his life. He lived to realize many of them including: President and Director of several banks in Austin and San Antonio, author of books on banking and business, and entrepreneur in real estate and business ventures. He was born in Lubbock, Texas in 1933. In the late 1950s he was stationed in Japan as a cold war intelligence officer during the Korean conflict. He married Joyce Page in 1957, and Rosalie Fore Glass in 1978.

He is survived by his two sons Perry and Michael Taylor, his two stepchildren Kathy Glass McCreight and David Glass, his sisters Dell Page, Jenna Spear, his brother Jim Taylor, 7 grandchildren and 3 great grandchildren. He lived most of his life in San Antonio, Austin, and in the Houston area and spent much time on the Texas coast.

He will be missed by his family and friends. May God bless him.
