John Collin Whitehurst was born on October 28, 1940, in the Philippines. He went peacefully on February 15, 2025, at the age of 84. John was the son of Major Collin B. Whitehurst Jr. He spent a short time in the Philippines and came to the United States in May of 1941. He then lived with his maternal grandparents until 1947 when he went to live with his mother and new stepfather, Robert Wesselhoeft Jr. His stepfather was in the oil business, and they lived in a variety of places in West Texas. He graduated from Abilene High School in 1960, and he attended Whittier College and graduated from Texas State University in 1972. He worked in accounting, and he eventually got a master’s in social work from Our Lady of the Lake University and worked in health care as a social worker mostly in the field of dialysis. John retired in the late 90’s and lived in San Antonio. He was a member of The Episcopal Church of the Holy Spirit. John was very interested in railroading and made several trips to New Mexico to pursue his interest. He made several trips to New York and Massachusetts to visit his three nephews and his sister-in-law. In his life he went from growing up in a very dysfunctional unhappy family to being a part of a very happy loving family. John is survived by his sister-in-law Dianne his nephews Johannes, Robert and Christian Wesselhoeft and Cousin Jessica Underwood from Oklahoma.
