Jose V. Chavarria, born on September 24, 1945, in San Antonio, Texas, passed away peacefully on April 29, 2025, at the age of 79.

A proud graduate of Brackenridge High School, Class of 1965, Jose went on to attend Cerritos College, where he earned an Associate in Art degree. He served his country with honor and distinction for 33 years, including active duty during the Vietnam War. 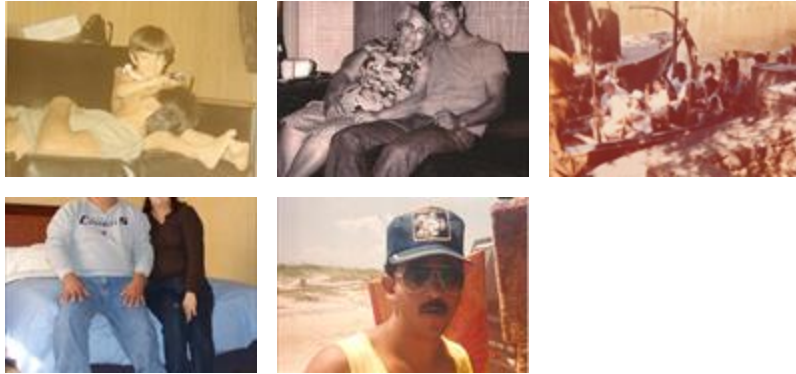
