February 24, 1977 - May 5, 2024

Jose Alfredo Lozano age 47 , passed away on May 5th 2024 in San Antonio Texas.

Jose Alfredo was born in San Antonio to Jose A. Lozano and Mary Joe (Josie) Lozano on Feb. 24th 1977. He attended Catholic Schools his entire life at St. Gregory The Great, Central Catholic High School and received his Bachelors of Arts degree in Communications at Marquette University (Milwaukee, WI). He worked as an intern at Milwaukee PBS; was hired full time and became an award winning videographer; winning three regional Emmy Awards as part of a team focusing on Latino and African American issues, and on his own producing documentaries. Later he moved on to St. Louis Missouri and worked as a freelance videographer. When both of his parents became seriously ill he returned to San Antonio to care for them.

Jose Alfredo Lozano is survived by his parents, and his former wife Bridget Barth Lozano, son Jose Emerson Lozano and aunts and uncles: Yolanda and Ruben Garza, Diane and John Saenz and Geraldine and Richard Balderas. And cousins that were like brother and sisters Ruben Garza Jr., Dr. Natalie Garza and Mauricio Amaya and Amanda and Shawn DeLeon. And best friend Julie Ross and lifelong friend Joe A. Alvarez.

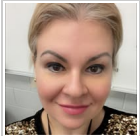

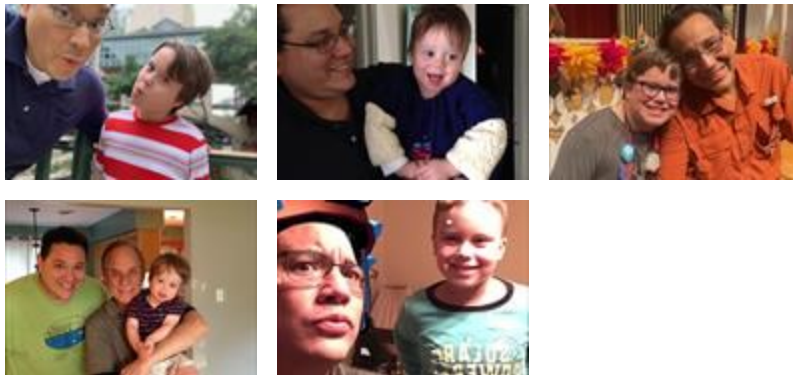
