Jose R. Mireles, Jr. beloved husband, father and grandfather, brother, and uncle peacefully entered into eternal rest on January 24, 2008. He is preceded in death by his father, Jose P. In the 1980's when he returned to San Antonio, he attended International Bible College where he obtained his degree in theology. Soon after, he began his own ministry and created the Mi Refugio Halfway House. He spent his remaining years employed with University Hospital. He is survived in death by his wife, Linda S.
