Joseph "Joe" Louie Moy passed away peacefully at home in Naples, Florida on December 20th, 2014, with his daughter, Debbie, at his side. He attended Fox Tech High School and served in the Army in World War II in the Philippines. Joe suffered with Parkinson's disease the last 7 years of his life. He always did his best despite losing his mobility, and eventually his ability to speak, but he never complained, he just went about his business, as he used to say, "slow-by-slow". He held a very special place in the hearts of all those who met him, he was one of God's Angels on earth. Joe was in management with the Civil Service at Kelly Field and retired after 30 years, then went to work for the Dee Howard Company and retired in 1989. He was a life member of the Knights of Columbus, 4th Degree, in San Antonio, Texas, and at the age of 85 was a volunteer with the Naples Regional Library and the Friends Of The Library in Collier County Florida. He was married to his wife Geraldine Bueche Moy for 46 years and raised three children. Joe was predeceased by his wife in 1999, and is survived by his sister Virginia Morkovsky in San Antonio, Texas, his sister Mary Dreyer in Plano, Texas, his three children, Debbie Thomas and husband Fred McGowin in Naples Florida, Jayne Abee and husband Carl
