Juan E. Aguilar, beloved father and grandfather entered eternal rest on July 14 at the age of 85. He was born October 23, 1929, in Laredo, Texas. Juan is now reunited with his loving wife, Carmen C. Aguilar, of 35 years of marriage. He is survived by daughter Janie T. Grover Daniel, sons Juan A.
