Juan R. Maldonado, age 87, passed peacefully on Monday, June 3, 2013 at Methodist VITAS Hospice Unit in San Antonio, Texas. Juan was a veteran of World War II, where he earned the Good Conduct Medal and Victory Medal. He served in the Army overseas with the 28th Army Infantry Division, and more specifically within, the 667th Air Materials Squadron at Ardennes, Rhineland, and Central Europe; and was Honorably Discharged on December 3, 1945. He was also a lifetime member of the VFW. Juan was born and raised in Crystal City, Texas and worked as a farm laborer until he entered the military. After his discharge he briefly worked for the railroad until he moved to San Antonio, Texas. He delivered oil for Valero and was promoted to a supervisory position in the warehouse.
