Juanita H. Allen, born November 17, 1915, went to be with the Lord on Friday, January 1, 2010 at the age of 94. Mrs. Allen was born in Limestone, Texas, was a former resident of Pleasanton and lived in San Antonio since 1942. She, along with her husband Rev. E.O. Allen, Sr. had a combined 75 years of ministry. She started Children's and Youth Ministry at what was known as Southside Gospel Church which currently is Omega Church. They also pastored in Pleasanton, Jourdanton, Harper and San Antonio.
