Mrs. Juanita Faye Taylor, age 96, was welcomed home by her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Thursday, April 18, 2019. Juanita, known to her friends and family as Nita and later Nana, was born to William Fred and Lydia Augusta (Graves) Wearden on October 7, 1922 in Tama, Texas, which was enveloped by the expansion of the U.S. Army base, Ft. Hood. As a result, the family relocated to Winters, Texas, where she remained through high school. As a young adult, she moved to San Angelo, TX, which is where she met the love of her life, T.H. "Hank" Taylor; the two enjoyed a 47 year marriage until his death in 1993.

Nita dedicated her life to her family and her Christian faith. She carried this dedication with her throughout the numerous relocations as an Air Force family.
