She worked as an Aerographer's Mate/ Meteorology Occups. while stationed in Jacksonville, Florida. There she met Edgar Earl Jennings, whom she married on July 1, 1965. They were married 52 years, until his passing in 2017. She was honorably discharged January 12, 1968. She received the Good Conduct Medal FIRST AWARD and the National Defense Service Medal. She spent several years as a homemaker raising 3 daughters until she returned to work, mostly clerical duties. She retired from the City of San Antonio after years of working for the City Library, last location was the downtown branch. Survivors include Jennifer Longoria (Ralph), Terri Kiel (Harry), and estranged daughter, Tina Hudel (Rick), grandsons Elliot Longoria, estranged grandsons, Christopher Jennings, Joshua Jennings, and Gene Hudel.
