Julian Segura was called to be with the Lord on February 11, 2025, at the age of 83 in the comfort of his home in San Antonio, Texas, surrounded by his loving family.

Julian was born in Poteet, Texas, to Martin Segura and Rosalia (Terrazas) Segura on February 18, 1941. No stranger to hard work, Julian was a soldier in the United States Army until 1968; he retired from Kelly Air Force base in San Antonio in 1998 after years of service.
