



## Julius (Sonny) Rathman Kahn

January 12, 1930 - July 16, 2018

Julius (Sonny) Rathman Kahn, age 88, born January 12, 1930 in San Antonio, Texas was called home by our Lord on Monday, July 16, 2018. Sonny graduated from Central Catholic High School in 1947 and joined the Navy in 1951. Following his military service, he joined his father in the family laundry and dry cleaning business until he opened his own, Bonner Supply Co. Then he sold the business and began working for W.P. Ballard & Co until his retirement in 2000.
