June Henderson died peacefully in her sleep at her home on December 6, 2007. A Memorial Service for June will be held at First Unitarian Universalist Church of San Antonio at 2:00PM on Saturday, January 5th, followed by a reception. June earned her Bachelor's degree from Baylor University and a Masters in English from the University of Texas at Austin. June taught at Miami-Dade, Florida and in Cuero, Texas before becoming a professor of English at San Antonio College 1984-1992. While at SAC, June chaired the World Literature Committee, served with distinction on the San Antonio College Faculty Senate, and was active in the American Association of University Professors. She was granted Professor Emeritus upon her retirement. After her retirement, June continued her profound love for English Literature by reading and participating in several literary discussion groups. She also loved international travel, making several overseas trips, especially enjoying her trip to Ireland where she could indulge both her love of travel and her love of genealogy while searching for her Irish roots. Her community activities

included being an active member of the First Unitarian Universalist Church., the San Antonio Museum Association, the San Antonio Audubon Society, the Alamo Chapter of the Sierra Club, the Genealogy Society of San Antonio, and the Texas Folklore Society. She also frequented many local cultural events such as the symphony, opera, choral groups, etc. She will be deeply missed by her many friends and associates.
