He was driven by generosity, laughter, and a deep sense of purpose. Known for his playful humor, boundless energy, and his ability to make everyone around him feel loved and valued, Justin's kindness, competitive mind, and wisdom left lasting impressions on all who knew him.

Justin was a proud graduate of Judson High School and went on to earn his degree in Business Management from the University of Texas at San Antonio. During his college years, he was an active member and athlete within the UTSA Filipino Student Association, where he built lifelong friendships and celebrated his cultural heritage. He also performed with the Karilagan Philippine Cultural Group throughout high school and college, sharing his talent, love for music, dance, and community.

A lifelong sports enthusiast, Justin was a devoted fan of the San Francisco 49ers, San Antonio Spurs, and San Francisco Giants. His passion for golf was unmatched, he was a talented player and a proud member of the San Antonio Minority Golf Association, where he found both competition and brotherhood among close friends. He held key positions with USAA and Rackspace, and later served as Co-Founder and Chief Revenue Officer of two international technology startups. Throughout his career, Justin closed some of the largest deals in company history, leaving a lasting mark through his dedication, integrity, and results.
