Justine O'Quinn of San Antonio, went home to be with the Lord on October 24, one day before his 93rd Birthday. After graduating from Brackenridge High School in San Antonio, Justine worked as a dental technician. At the age of 30, Justine joined the Navy to serve his country during WWII. After four years of service in the Pacific, Justine began a lengthy and distinguished career in the insurance industry, first with Washington National and then for many years with Bankers Life and Casualty Company. Justine was known for his gregarious Irish nature, his quick wit and engaging storytelling. And his practical jokes! His talents and interests were many and varied.
