



Justus J.W. Wilson Walls

Justus Wilson J. W. Walls passed away December 24, 2004. He was the eldest son of Jesse Warren J. W. Walls and Bertha Lee Peach Walls having been born on May 19, 1920 in Mineral Wells, Texas. He is survived by his wife, Mary Pearl Merket Walls whom he married on January 15, 1939 in Levelland, Texas. He is also survived by John Warren J. W. Walls, his eldest son; Ray Edward Walls, his youngest son; and, Mary Ellen Walls Wright, his only daughter. He is also survived by three grandsons and a great-grandson.
