Karen Fell, 68, peacefully passed into the arms of our Lord on Good Friday morning, April 22, 2011. She was born and raised in Mobile, Alabama, and moved to San Antonio with her family in 1967. Karen was preceded in death by her father, Silas Quitman Fell, and is survived by her mother, Anna Mary, her sisters, Chris and Donna, and her long-time friend and housemate, Pattye Byrom.
