Karen Jo Linares Weaver of Overland Park, Kansas passed away on March 13, 2011 in Overland Park. She was born October 24, 1956 in San Antonio, Texas to parents Hector H. Linares and Josephine G. Linares.

Karen Jo graduated from Robert E. Lee High School, received her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Biology and Bachelor of Science Degree in Pharmacy from The University of Texas at Austin. While employed as a Pharmacist at Methodist Hospital Karen Jo graduated from St. Mary's University School of Law, San Antonio Texas where she received her Juris Doctorate and passed the Texas Bar Exam on her first attempt.

Karen Jo was preceded in death by her mother Josephine G. Linares, twin brothers David Joseph and Bryon Joseph Linares. Survivors include her husband Michael C. Weaver, her father Hector H.
