Karrie became a full time stay at home mom, leaving behind her career and leisurely activities to become a devoted wife and mother. She was a talented seamstress. She handmade many of their outfits during their childhood, buying fabric and spending hours on the sewing machine tailoring

their Christmas dresses, easter dresses, fiesta dresses, and many other outfits for various special occasions, including Halloween.

She loved Halloween and always came up with the most original family costumes that were always her own creations. She enjoyed the annual family haunted houses where she rallied the neighborhood to participate to give everyone the scariest and best experience possible. She loved her community and anything that brought joy to her children.

She was actively involved in the girls education serving as PTA President for two terms at Woodstone Elementary. She made gingerbread houses in each of their classrooms, Easter basket cupcakes, and Lincoln hats for each child for Lincoln Look Alike Day among many other activities. She was incredibly talented and patient. She made so many beautiful friendships during this time.

Karrie was also a Girl Scout leader for many years and enjoyed camping and other outdoor events. She was the head coach for the girls Pop Warner cheerleading teams. Her dedication and devotion to coaching them over the years eventually sent them to nationals in Disney World, with daughter Ashlee junior coaching alongside her. When the girls reached High School, she traveled with them to Disney World to attend their UCA Cheerleading Championship competitions every year, as well as any other place their extra curricular activities took her. She never missed an event of theirs. She continued the legacy by watching her granddaughters participate and compete in cheer competitions. Karrie was loved by every child she crossed paths with.

Not only did she excel at motherhood, she was a dedicated and driven employee throughout her life in the workforce. She made friends and life long relationships throughout her career and was very proud of any and all achievements that she or her friends accomplished along the way. One of her

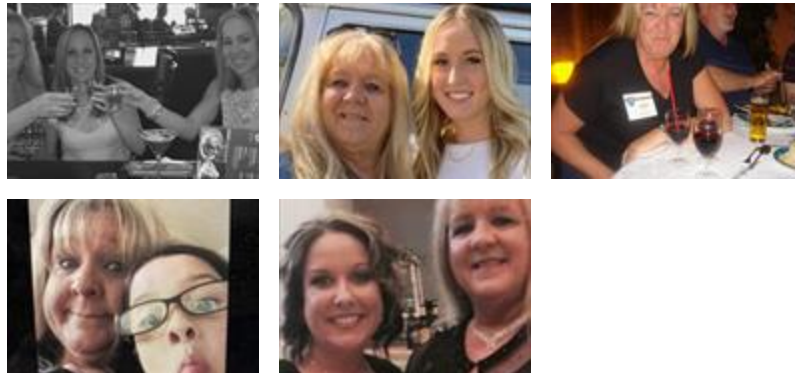
