Kate Rojean James, 85, of San Antonio, Texas went home to the loving embrace of her Savior on February 1st, after a full & blessed life of service to her Lord, family, and community.

She was born in Grandfield, OK to John and Viola Talbot. Although her family lived in a dugout house with a dirt floor during her early years, they were rich in love and the blessings of Jesus Christ.

Rojean graduated from San Antonio's Harlandale High School in 1954, married Gary Boubel Sr. in 1955, had their son Gary Boubel Jr. in 1956 and their daughter Marie Boubel in 1957, and was widowed in 1958. While working for the telephone company and taking night classes at San Antonio College, she met Clarence "Jesse" James; they married in 1964 and had their son Forrest in 1965 to complete another family rich in love.

In addition to running the household, "Mom" was very involved in the lives of her children and their activities in the community. She was the Team Mother for several Highland Hawks Pop Warner football teams, and baseball teams at Kienberg Field and Southeast PONY Baseball; held offices (Secretary, Treasurer, President) in the PTA at Kate Schenck Elementary, Rogers Middle School, Highlands High School and the Booster Club at Highlands High School. Mom also ran more candy sales and fundraisers, and sewed more

Highlands Brigade and Dance Team uniforms than we care to count.

As “Maw Maw”, she was the first and best daycare for her grandchildren, and provided world class in-home daycare to other children whose parents were blessed enough to make their way to the top of the list. Maw Maw’s love for her grandchildren was immeasurable and unconditional, and she seldom missed the opportunity to support one of their events: Grandparents Day at their school, their academic & sporting competitions, and their theatrical performances... not to mention the countless pick-ups in the SACS carpool.

Whether you knew her as Rojean, Aunt Jean, Mrs. James, Sister James, or Maw Maw, she was a pillar of her community, a living testimony, and a dearly beloved daughter, sister, wife, mother, grandmother, great-grandmother, aunt, and friend. The quote they inscribed next to her high school senior photo described her well, “Love, sweetness and goodness in her person shone”.

She was preceded in death by her husband of 52 years, Clarence “Jesse” James; her brothers Blaine Crouse and Glade Crouse, and her sister Daryce Nottingham. She is survived by her sister Donna Boubel (Bruce); step-son David James (Jeanie); sons Gary Boubel and Forrest James (Erika); daughter Marie Boubel Raymond (Tom); 3 grandchildren (Justin Bergh, Rachel James, and Rebecca James); 1 great grandson (Brydon Bergh), and extended family members and friends.
